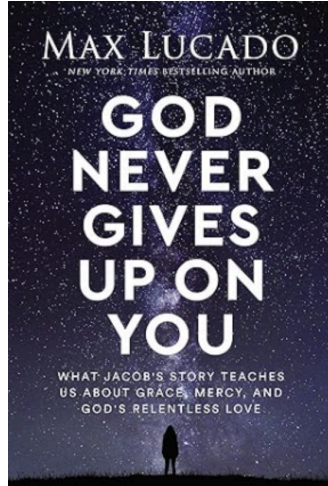
## A SEASON OF PSALMS
