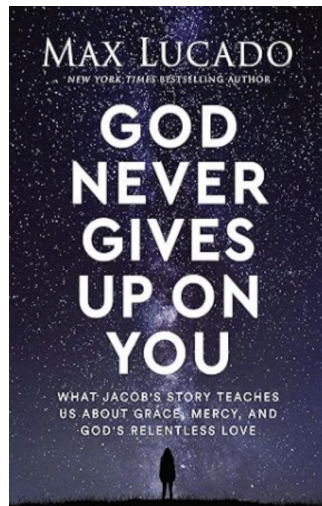
A SEASON OF PSALMS
